- 1. The first time he saw a police officer up close, Cap was arrested for driving without a license. He was thirteen and driving his grandmother Rain to the hospital.
- 2. Living on Garland Farm, a commune that had once been populated by fourteen families, allowed Cap and Rain to "escape the money-hungry rat race of modern society."
- 3. Cap was homeschooled because he and Rain wanted to "avoid the low standards and cultural poison of a world that had lost its way."
- 4. Rain and Cap didn't' believe in competition and trophies and medals, which were symbols of an empty soul. Rain also suspected that the whole thing was a trick to get Cap to go to regular school.
