Each of the 30 cards in this set presents a sentence with an underlined word. Students are challenged to identify **two correct classifications** for the word from a set of four possible answers.

These cards are designed for use by 6th, 7th, and 8th graders as a review and new skills reinforcement. They are not appropriate for students just beginning to study nouns. Users must have a working knowledge of common and proper, singular and plural, possessive, collective, concrete and abstract. A reference page that briefly defines the 8 noun terms is included for student use at the teacher's discretion.

- a student instruction card
- 30 task cards
- student answer sheets
- full answer keys

Preparation Instructions: The cards are formatted in color, but they also work well in grayscale.

- Cut card pages vertically at 5½" and individual cards horizontally at 4".

Please keep in mind that different printers cause the cards to move around on the page slightly, so you might have to make some cutting adjustments.
